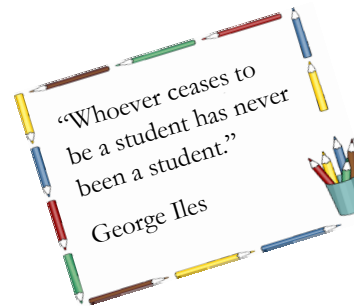

Title II Funds

This federally funded program is also known as The Teacher and Principal Training and Recruiting Fund. In Putnam County these funds are utilized to; recruit highly qualified teachers; support professional development for staff in Putnam County Schools’ and provide supplemental teaching materials for training. We also offer professional development services to private and charter schools in Putnam County.

Title II Services Include:

- Curriculum Resource Teachers in selected schools.
- Research based training to improve student achievement.
- Materials to support training.
- District Content Area Coaches
- Training for school administrators.

- Incentives for teachers who earn the Reading Endorsement or during the 2016-2017 school year and teach in Putnam County during the 2017-2018 school year.
- Tuition and Course Reimbursement to attain highly qualified status.
- Instructional substitutes for teachers attending trainings.
- Stipends for teachers attending training outside their contract day.
- Consultant fees.
- Out of county travel for staff to attend workshops.
- Recruitment incentives for highly qualified teachers in critical storage areas.
- Web-based professional development courses.
