Title VI Performance Goal:

Goal: Each participating LEA will decrease the proportion of high school students not earning a standard diploma by 10% each school year.

The Putnam County School District plans to utilize Title VI Funds to implement the following strategies to decrease the proportion of high school students not earning a standard diploma:

- Educational Technology, including software, to support digital curriculum;
- Activities authorized under Part A of Title I - Web based curriculum for intervention support for students who need to improve their GPA for graduation and or recover credits for courses that they failed.
- District Elementary Math Coach

PCSD anticipated outcome:

By the end of the 2016-2017 year, graduation rates from the most current data available will show a 10% decrease in the percentage of students not earning a standard diploma as compared to the graduation data for the previously reported year.

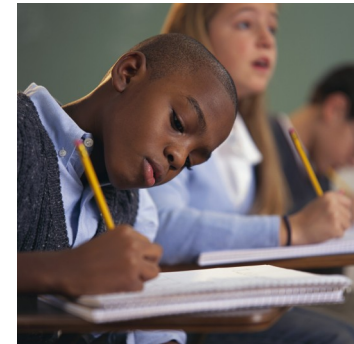

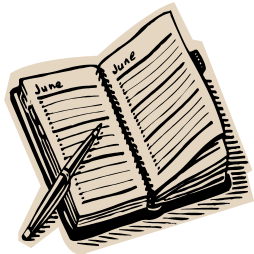

Goal: Decrease the proportion of the cohort of students 4th-10th grade scoring non-proficient on Florida’s adopted assessment(s) in reading, mathematics and writing by 10% each school year.

The Putnam County School District Plans to utilize Title VI Funds to implement the following strategies to improve the academic performance of our disadvantaged students:

- Teacher professional development on the Florida Standards;
- Teacher professional development on the utilization of technology to improve teaching;
- Teacher professional development to support quality instruction for students with disabilities;
- Teacher professional development to support quality instruction for English Language acquisition;

- Educational technology, including software and hardware, to support digital curriculum;
- Activities authorized under part A of Title I-Web based curriculum for intervention support for students who need to improve their GPA for graduation and or recover credits for courses that they failed.

PCSD anticipated outcome:

By the end of the 2016-2017 school year, data from FSA ELA and Math will show that Putnam County Students participating in activities funded with Title VI, Part B funds have improved by 10%.

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
