**2017-2018 Neglected and Delinquent Services Plan**

The Office of Federal Programs has dedicated a Resource Teacher to spend 75% of his time to supporting LEA neglected and delinquent students. Along with coordinating **transition services** for students transitioning back to school from delinquent centers, he will **coordinate and push in social services** at each of the long-term ISS centers. Social services will be coordinated with organizations such as:

- Juvenile Crime Prevention
- Corner Drug Store
- SEDNET
- Handley Center
- DCF
- DJJ
- CareerSource

The weekly schedule for social services at the ISS centers will be coordinated by the Resource Teacher to include services such as quick delivery social skills training (ex: Know the Law, Anger Management, etc.). In addition to social services coordination, the Resource Teacher will provide individual and small group support to students during the credit recovery and curriculum delivery process in order to support student motivation and academics with the goal of standards proficiency and on-track graduation. Individual and small group student support will be delivered via the following weekly schedule:
