

## Other Career and Educational Opportunities



**Career Pathways** program is a high school applied technology program linked with a post secondary program which may lead to a certificate program, associate's degree, and/or bachelor's degree. Through applied academics and technical studies, the student will build his/her competencies in communication, mathematics, and science.



**Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program: The Gold Seal Endorsement Program** focuses on students who have performed well in career preparatory programs. It recognizes and rewards excellence for academic achievement and career preparation.



**Dual Enrollment** students may earn free college credits and high school credits their junior and/or senior year at SJRSC, DBC or SFC. Students must meet the criteria of a 3.0 UGPA and have a college placement score (ACT, SAT, CPT, or PERT) on file.



**Career Dual Enrollment** students may take courses during their junior and/or senior year at FCTC or SJRSC working towards a specific career path. Students must meet the criteria of a 2.0 UGPA and must meet the requirement for the

PERT reading and writing. Some courses require an age limit to be enrolled.

## Certified Nursing Assistant



Clinical and laboratory experience is provided.

This course is designed to teach students about the care giving and clinical aspects of the Health Science Education Program. Students will experience practical

hands on experience at the hospital and nursing home.

Students will be required to complete a SJRSC and Nursing Assistant application, purchase a uniform, and present an up-to-date immunization record to include the Hepatitis B series, Tuberculosis skin test, pass a back-ground check and drug screening test.

The class will be offered as a Dual Enrollment course, with St Johns River State College, as part of the Health Science Education Program. Students must have a 2.0 GPA, has taken or currently enrolled in an HSE Program (Allied Health or EKG/HHA), and be able to provide own transportation, as some classes may be offered outside of the traditional school day/hours.

Students will sit for the State CNA Exam upon completion of the program.



## Purpose and Intent

The purpose of this program is to prepare a student for employment as a Certified Nurses Assistant.

After successfully completing this program, the student will be able to describe an overview of the human body, use correct medical terminology, identify the structure and function of the body systems and identify and explain factors relating to the transmission of disease.
