

CHAPTER 3.00 - SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION

HOLIDAYS DEFINED

3.28

The following days shall be paid holidays for all twelve (12) months employees not in a bargaining unit(s): Independence Day (July 4th), Labor Day, Thursday and Friday of the week of Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day and New Year's Day. In addition, paid holidays equal to those allocated to teachers and other ten (10) month employees shall be awarded. School holiday(s) shall appear on the approved school calendar for ten (10) month employees or shall be established by action of the School Board.

1. When a legal holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, the holiday will be taken the preceding or following workday as determined by the School Board.
2. All schools will observe the legal holidays as provided herein unless special permission is granted by the School Board to deviate from the established school calendar.
