

CHAPTER 4.00 - CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION

SCHOOL SPONSORED TRIPS

4.24

Single day school sponsored trips within the State of Florida may be approved by the school principal.

Overnight trips and trips outside of the State of Florida shall be approved in advance by the District School Board except in situations where there is not sufficient time for School Board approval prior to the date of the trip or in emergency situations. In these instances, the Superintendent is authorized to approve such trips on a case-by-case basis. Following Superintendent Approval, a request shall nevertheless be submitted to the District School Board for retroactive approval at their next School Board meeting.

When arranging school trips, the principal will verify the valid driver's license of anyone transporting students in private vehicles. In addition, students participating on a school trip must submit a permission form (PCDSB FORM #D-119) signed by the parent or guardian. The permission forms are to accompany the person in charge during the trip.
